

## **Section 3.1 B-Zone Blind Permit Allocation Procedures**

The procedures for acquiring a B-Zone Blind Permit are as follows:

1. On the first Friday in September at 7:00-10:00 pm the staff at the Rondeau Waterfowl Unit Office will issue B-Zone Blind Permits to erect a blind in order of the individual's position in the line up. The Waterfowl Office will also be open on Saturday morning from 8:00-10:00 am for the purchase of B Zone blind erect permits

2. The line up may begin on the Friday 12 am (Thursday Midnight) before the first Friday in September.

3. Upon arrival at the line up outside the RBWU Office each individual intending to purchase a B-Zone Blind Permit must sign in with the attendant. You must have proper Provincial Park Vehicle Permits for the duration of your line up stay.

4. The person must remain within the immediate vicinity of the RBWU Office until he/she purchases their B-Zone Blind Permit on Saturday, failure to remain in line will result in loss of position in line.

5. Every person in line may only purchase one B-Zone Blind Permit, if you would like a second permit you must return to the end of the line.

6. To purchase a B-Zone Blind Permit a Seasonal B-Zone Permit, a valid Outdoors Card including a small game licence along with a valid Migratory Game Bird Stamp and Permit are required.

7. Once issued a permit to build a blind the individual will be required to indicate where they plan on positioning their blind on the B-Zone Map located at the Rondeau Waterfowl Unit Office. No blind may be erected before obtaining the B-Zone Blind Permit and until after the Tuesday following Labour Day.
